The Chief Benchers Report 2023

We had fourteen initiations throughout the year, representing 317 persons from twenty-four different countries.

The assembly took place on Thursday, February 28, in a crowded cellar, where former emergency chief Jørgen Petersen, as chairman, guided the assembly smoothly through the agenda.

Various awards were given out, including Soldier of the Year: Jonas Høvring Skov Initiative Award: Safe House by Martin Bossen Aalborg Award: Café Parasollen by Lise Hansen Honorary Award: Raise for Kids by Sonja Christensen

Following this, the initiations proceeded in the usual calm and orderly manner.

On March 17, we attended a reception at Duus's wine cellar where hosts Peter Kragh and Mrs. Lene presented their beautiful renovation of the cellar. We encourage others to see the results. On the same occasion, we presented a bronze cannon found at Skagen.

This year, we also had two initiations from UNMIL-POC, which, as usual, were festive ceremonies with many languages and different uniforms, adding color to Aalborg.

On Saturday, June 17, we had the pleasure of initiating fifteen students from the American Coast Guard training ship Eagle. It was delightful to see mariners in the cellar again.

Another pleasant initiation was of seventeen individuals from the Odd Fellow sister lodge, where, as always, beautiful singing filled the air when many "ladies" were present.

From Norway, on April 29, we had a fine initiation of thirty-eight people from Kristiansand, Grimstad, and Sarpsborg, creating a very pleasant atmosphere. July 4th, as always, was a significant initiation, this year with twenty-seven people, making the cellar bustling with activity. In Rebild Bakker, we had a tent lunch in a completely sold-out tent. Very nice atmosphere, where we distributed ties and newly designed scarves (for the ladies) to the speakers. Also, the debut of our new C4 Cap.

In 2023, Christian the Fourth's Guild Fund donated approximately 75,000 DKK to various charitable causes. The payout took place in Duus's wine cellar on May 4, where the Guild hosted hot dogs and beer, along with entertainment by Hunting Horn Blowers and Pensioner Orchestra. Afterward, we went to Helligandsklostret, where there was a tour and mention of the Churchill Club. Afterwards, there was a communal singing at Gammel Torv.

The year brought many good events, although we had to bid farewell to former board member Per Svensson, who passed away in February.

The board has a great collaboration, where everyone "pull in the same direction". I would like to commend our two troubadours who do an excellent job during the initiations.

Delightful initiations in 2023

We began the year's initiations on February 11, 2023, where new members from the company K-Properties and the Aalborg Guide Association were initiated.

Next, there was an initiation of Norwegian friends from Kristiansand and Sarpsborg on April 29th. Here, we had the pleasure of initiating not less than 38 new members. Additionally, there were many guests, so the second floor of the wine cellar had to be used. It is obvious that the Chief Bencher entertained with Norwegian anecdotes, including one about the young priest in Northern Norway and his issues with the congregation. However, the overall atmosphere was cheerful throughout. Another significant initiation took place in the month of August. This time, it involved the initiation of no less than 46 new members from the Cimbria Lodge in Aalborg. The Freemasonry lodge forwarded the article they wrote about the initiation. Quote: "Freemasons, their families, and good friends from Randers to Skagen defied the gloomy weather forecasts and flocked to Aalborg. The Freemasonry lodge filled the entire basement of Jens Bang's Stone House, including the first floor. The Chief Bencher, along with the benchers, delivered a fantastic and colorful

International activities also thrive in the Guild. In addition to the initiation in connection with the Rebild Festival, the Guild had two more international initiations with Unmilpoc. This is because Aalborg engages in the training of international military police, organized in Unmilpoc. Twice a year, there is training/course at the Military Police in Aalborg. Each course usually lasts for 14 days. Traditionally, after visiting the Town Hall, the students are initiated into the Christian the Fourth Guild. This time, we also had a visit from one of Unmilpoc's leaders, a Colonel from Bulgaria. This has led to the initiation of new members from no less than 14 different nations.

Finally, in the month of October, we had what we call an autumn initiation. This initiation included new members from Aalborg and Vendsyssel.

These are individuals or couples who wish to join the Guild, and we are, of course, happy about that. Although the October weather was changeable, we managed to complete the city tour through the old and new Aalborg. Fortunately, the participants had made sure to wear outerwear, so the trip did not become too strenuous. Inside the warmth, the participants were subjected to the "tough" initiation ritu-



al, and our two-man band again ensured a festive atmosphere, with the entire company singing along. It surely helped that the "potato juice" brought back the inner heat.
