During the luncheon, the Chief Bencher awarded: Ambassador Alan Leventhal, Danish main speaker Jens Bjerg Sørensen, American main speakers Casper Phillipson and Anders Agner, each with a Christian the Fourth Tie.

Just when this year's Rebild luncheon was over, a terrific rain and thunderstorm broke out. It delayed the start in the hills with about 45 minutes. People were happy, that they had remembered their umbrella/raincoat!!

We also had the pleasure of initiating thirty-four crew members from the frigate Absalon, Aalborg city’s adoption ship. - Nice to see sailors in the wine cellar again.

Bencher Per Svensson had, after 25 years of service to the Board, wanted to step down. We said farewell on 31th of March, with a small ceremony in “Laugsslokalet”, where we thanked Per and Mrs Else for the great work they had been during over the many years.

The Guild’s Fund is again in good shape, we paid out a good dkr. 95,000 in 2022 to worthy causes.

2022 was also the year we lost our “Musical Conductor” of 22 years, Per Iversen. Per was a God-given musician and showman who has brought out smiles to thousands of new Guild members.



The Foundation of Christian the Fourth Guild

In 2022 the annual return of our assets had improved, so we were able to pay out around dkr. 95.000 to several good courses.

The distribution took place on May 4th, the day Denmark was liberated in 1945.

To mention a few recipients: "Obelpigerne" dkr. 2000, author Uffe Westerberg - a new book about the Churchill Club dkr. 5.000. Hospice Vangen dkr. 5.000. Lung Associations Network Group dkr. 3.000. "Strikkepigerne" på Vestergården dkr. 2.500.

After the donations had been paid out, we walked to Aalborg Monastery (300 meters away), where there were a new exhibition about the "Churchill group", the first Danish resistance group. The group was founded at Aalborg Monastery in 1941.

After 25 years as Chairman of the Foundation, former Mayor Kaj Kjær had decided to resign, after having done an excellent job.

Newly elected to the Foundation is Professor Michael Slavensky Dahl. Other members of the Foundation Board are: Ernst Trillingsgaard, Vibeke Gamst, Jens-Chr. Schmidt and Niels Voss Hansen.

The new Chairman is Vibeke Gamst.
